



Thank you for your interest in becoming an OEC instructor. The following are the steps to becoming an OEC instructor in the EMARI region. These steps need to be following the order stated below.

1. Patrollers interested in becoming an instructor are to submit an instructor application to the ROA.
2. Attend an Instructor Development Class (Bill Devarney is the ID coordinator for the EMARI region) or take the Instructor Development class online.
3. If you choose to take the course online your next step is to meet with the ID coordinator for a “one on one” meeting to complete the course.
4. The course completion record for an ID class or the one on one meeting after an ID online class should be submitted to the ROA. This form is completed and submitted by the Instructor of Record.
5. The ROA will assign a mentor for the instructor candidate.
6. At that point you will (with your mentor) observe another instructor during an OEC class.
7. During the mentoring period, you are required to teach lessons on two (or more if the mentor feels necessary) occasions while being monitored by an instructor in good standing. You may co-teach with another instructor during one or both of these.
8. When the mentor feels you are ready for a final observation the mentor will contact an IT and the final observation is scheduled.
